Prayer Preparation

Prepare your mind and heart to come before God with reverence and awe and to worship Him in spirit and truth. Ask God to hear your prayer. Hear my prayer, O LORD; give ear to my pleas for mercy! In your faithfulness answer me, in your righteousness! (Psalm 143:1).

Prayer Focus: Jesus Christ

<u>Praise God for Christ's Incarnation (that He took Humanity to Himself)</u> ~ Christ assumed humanity to perfectly identify with us, to live our life, and lay down his life in our stead. 'The only-begotten Son, one of the holy and consubstantial Trinity, who is perfect God by nature, has become a perfect human being in accordance with his will, by truly assuming flesh that is consubstantial with us and endowed with a rational soul and mind,' (Maximus the Confessor, early 7th Century). You may want to read John 1:1-4,14-18 and Phil.2:6-7.

<u>Praise God</u> for the Son's obedience to fulfill the demands of the Covenant, to fully identify with humanity ~ how glorious this truth is in our day of fear, anxiety, worry, sadness, and grief. <u>Let's pray</u> that people will turn to Him!

Prayer Guide: ACTS

Offer praise and worship to God by expressing your **adoration** and reverence for Him through your prayers. **Confess** and repent of corporate and personal sin asking God for forgiveness in His mercy and grace. Offer genuine and sincere **thanks** to God for what He has done and will do. Humbly bring your **requests** to God in prayer using the prayer points provided.
