Prayer Preparation

Prepare your mind and heart to come before God with reverence and awe and to worship Him in spirit and truth. Ask God to hear your prayers to Him. *Let my cry come before you, O LORD; give me understanding according to your word! Let my plea come before you; deliver me according to your word* (Psalm 119:169-170).

Prayer Focus: Attributes of God

God is **gracious**. God infinitely shows grace to mankind and saves sinners. *The LORD is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love* (Psalm 145:8). *For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast* (Ephesians 2:8-9).

Prayer Guide: ACTS

Offer praise and worship to God by expressing your **adoration** and reverence for Him through your prayers. **Confess** and repent of corporate and personal sin asking God for forgiveness in His mercy and grace. Offer genuine and sincere **thanks** to God for what He has done and will do. Humbly bring your **requests** to God in prayer using the prayer points provided.
