Key Word: Not to be ashamed

Author: Paul

<u>Date:</u> Written during Paul's imprisonment in Rome and shortly before his death. Some believe this was last of Paul's writings.

<u>Purpose:</u> Timothy had evidently become quite discouraged and Paul wrote to strengthen his faith and to encourage him to continue his work. At the end, he urged him to come to Rome and be with him.

  - 1. 2:14-18 Positive and negative subject matter of his teaching
  - 2. 2:19-21 Foundation of church stands sure in spite of two kinds of vessels
  - 3. 2:22-26 Personal counsel
    - a. verse 22 personal purity
    - b. verses 23-26 avoid strife but teach with patience, meekness, and hope

  - a. verses 8, 9 times of Moses as illustration
