Promise: God Will Not Forget His Promises

Scripture

“I will not forget you. Behold I have written your name on the palms of my hands.” Isaiah 49:15b-16a

Devotion

Go to the window and look outside. Do you see the green leaves on the trees and the green grass growing in your yard? Do you see flowers blooming all over the place? What you are seeing is a reminder from God that He has not forgotten His promises to you. In the Bible, after Noah and his family and all the animals came off the ark after the Great Flood was over, God made a promise to Noah that there would always be different seasons on the earth. So the fact that you can look out your window and see Winter is over and Spring has come is a reminder of God's promise to Noah. He has never forgotten that promise. God never forgets any of His promises. Because God is perfect and holy, He will never forget a single one of His promises to you. Not one!!

In fact, God cannot forget his promises to you because your name is always in front of him. He tells us in the Bible, in Isaiah 49:15-16, I will not forget you, Behold, I have written your name on the palms of my hands. What a great promise this is! This is a promise that God will never forget His promises to us!

The whole Bible is the story of God keeping His promises, most importantly His promise to send Jesus to rescue us from sin. Easter is almost here, and we will celebrate the life, death and resurrection of Jesus, the Promised Rescuer. God did not forget His promise to send Jesus, and that is proof that He will never forget His other promises to us.
