## Understand Your Heart

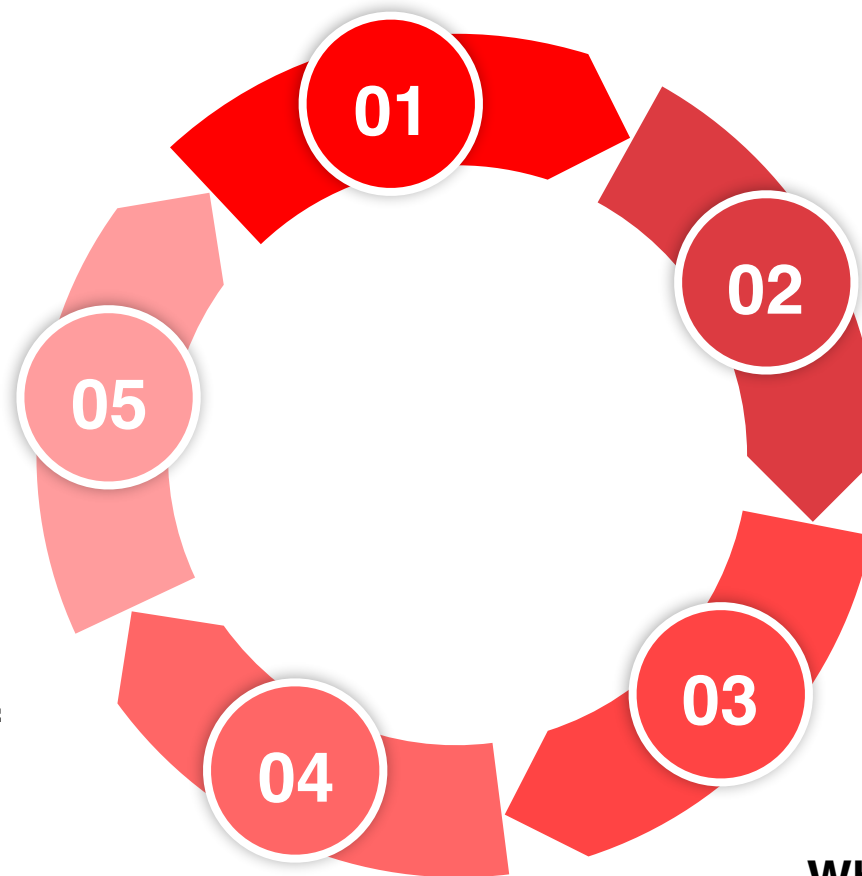
