After seeing the gymnasium for the first time, FPC covenant child Elsa Gray Forster could hardly contain her excitement. "The new gymnatorium is great," she said. "There is even a stage! I cannot wait to do a Christmas pageant or VBS skit or something in there."

The facility boasts 10 new state-of-the-art classrooms for First Presbyterian Day School, as well as a gymnasium/auditorium, walking track, and multipurpose room that will be shared by FPC and FPDS.


"This is something we have dreamed about for many years,"
